On behalf of AITE and Coach Claude Morest, and Simsbury High School and Coach Marty Leftoff, we would like to invite you to attend our third tournament of the 2016-17 season on Saturday, December 10. We will follow our standard tournament format.

Please read the following items carefully and note the deadline below:

1. With only two hosts, we have space for 410 debaters or 205 teams so we expect to be oversubscribed. Based on attendance at the October and November tournaments we would like schools to register as follows:

Simsbury Tournament: Amity, Crosby, Daniel Hand, E.O.Smith, East Catholic, Farmington, Glastonbury, Guilford, Hamden, Housatonic Valley, Loomis Chaffee, Pomperaug, Sacred Heart, Shepaug Valley, Simsbury, Westfield/Watkinson, Windsor, Woodbury, Xavier.

2. You must register your teams and judges through <u>tabroom.com</u>. Instructions for using tabroom.com for CDA can be found here: <u>http://ctdebate.org/PDFs/Using%20Tabroom.pdf</u>. We will be using <u>tabroom.com</u> for registration for all tournaments.

The tournament entry on <u>tabroom.com</u> has six events, Varsity, Novice and Observer for each of the three schools. You may choose the tournament you would like to attend by registering your debaters in the events for one high school or the other.

The tournament will be open for registration on Monday, November 28 at 8AM.

- 3. AS WE ARE LIKELY TO BE OVERSUBSCRIBED, ALL ENTRIES WILL BE WAITLISTED. ON <u>TUESDAY EVENING, DECEMBER 6, AT 9PM</u>, WE WILL ADMIT AS MANY TEAMS AS WE CAN. SCHOOLS THAT ENTER TEAMS AFTER TUESDAY EVENING AT 9PM WILL ONLY BE ADMITTED IF THERE IS SPACE AVAILABLE.
- 4. Please abide by the rules for Novice eligibility (unchanged from last year):

The Novice division will be open to Freshman and Sophomores, regardless of experience or record. They may qualify and participate as Novices in State Finals both years. However, they may move up to Varsity at any time if they or their coach choose, and once having moved up, may not return to Novice. Coaches are encouraged to move Sophomores up to Varsity if they have been successful as a Freshman, but are not required to do so.

Juniors who have never debated before in CDA may participate as Novices in their first regular CDA tournament. Otherwise they may only debate in Varsity. They may not participate in State Finals except in Varsity. They may only qualify for State Finals while debating in Varsity.

Seniors may not participate as Novices in any CDA tournament.

- 5. To qualify for State Finals, a debater must win a trophy at a regular tournament, or go 3-0 at two regular tournaments. In other words, simply going 3-0 at one tournament without winning a trophy will not qualify.
