Round 1 Motions

- THW instruct jurors to acquit when they believe that a law conviction would be against the public interest.

Round 2 Motions

Semi-finals

In 1954 the United States Supreme Court ruled that racial segregation in public schools was unconstitutional, ending segregationist practices that had persisted in parts of the U.S., including Arkansas, since the end of the Civil War. The Governor of Arkansas threatened to defy this decision using the National Guard and State law enforcement, leading to a stand-off with the Federal Government in which President Eisenhower promised Marine guards to any student agreeing to forcibly integrate the all-white Little Rock Central High School for the 1957-58 school year. As a Black parent living in Little Rock, Arkansas, in 1957 with no supernatural knowledge of the outcome, THBT you should volunteer your child to forcibly integrate the high school.
